Job Description	Key Responsibilities and Duties
	Rigging Operations
	o Prepare lifting plans as directed and identify safe rigging methods.
	<ul> <li>Select appropriate rigging gear (slings, chain blocks, shackles, wire ropes, hooks, spreader bars, etc.).</li> </ul>
	Inspect, install, and operate rigging equipment for lifting operations.
	Assist in loading and unloading heavy equipment and materials.
	<ul> <li>Signal crane operators using standard hand signals or communication devices.</li> </ul>
	Equipment & Material Handling
	Secure loads properly to prevent shifting, falling, or damage.
	O Assist in moving heavy machinery such as motors, pumps, gearboxes, conveyors, and structural components.
	<ul> <li>Use hoists, pulleys, hydraulic jacks, rollers, and winches during operations.</li> </ul>
	Safety Compliance
	o Perform pre-use inspection of rigging gear to identify defects or hazards.
	o Ensure lifting operations comply with safety standards and HSE regulations.
	<ul> <li>Maintain clear communication with crane operators and team members during</li> </ul>
	lifts.
	o Identify unsafe conditions, report hazards, and stop work if necessary.
	Maintenance & Storage of Rigging Tools
	Maintain rigging tools and equipment in good working condition.
	Keep inventory of rigging gear and report damage or wear.
	Ensure rigging tools are stored properly and safely after use.
	Support in Installation & Shutdown Activities
	Assist mechanical teams during installation, dismantling, or alignment of heavy
	machinery.
	<ul> <li>Support plant shutdowns, overhauls, and replacement of major components.</li> </ul>
	o Participate in heavy lifting tasks inside confined or restricted areas when required.
	Documentation
	<ul> <li>Maintain rigging checklists, equipment inspection logs, and activity reports.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Assist in preparing daily progress updates to supervisors.</li> </ul>
	Other Duties
	o Perform any other rigging or mechanical support tasks assigned by the supervisor.
	o Participate in safety drills, toolbox meetings, and training activities.
	o Perform any other tasks assigned by the Head/HoD/CEO.
